WHERE WILD MEETS WORLD-CLASS

The Wild Mustang & Burro Finals celebrates the unique abilities of wild-bred mustangs and burros, ethical horsemanship, and responsible training. Across four days and eight disciplines, the country's most talented trainers and owners bring gentled, accomplished animals into the arena to compete for national titles — an open-show championship built to inspire lifelong partnerships beyond adoption.

8 DISCIPLINES

Dressage/Western Dressage, Jumping, Western Versatility, Green Horse, In-Hand, Liberty, Freestyle & Speed Events

3 CLASSES

Every division entry includes three scored classes — win the division, take home the title. (Freestyle is a single class.)

50% PAYBACK+MORE

Division prize money equals 50% of entry fees, awarded to the top three overall placings. Plus, special sponsor prizes.

HOW THE COMPETITION WORKS

- 01 Qualify** your rider & animal combination at two horse shows during the qualification period, then enter on HorseSpot.
- 02 Compete** in all three classes of your chosen division. Each class awards ribbons 1st through 6th.
- 03 Earn the title.** Cumulative scores across the division crown the Champion, Reserve Champion & Third Overall.



THE EIGHT DISCIPLINES

Mustangs & burros can do anything. Each division entry includes the three classes shown; overall division score crowns the champion. Judge assignments are noted per discipline.

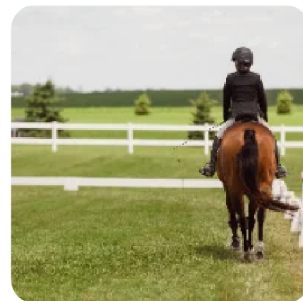

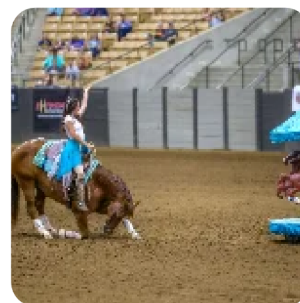
